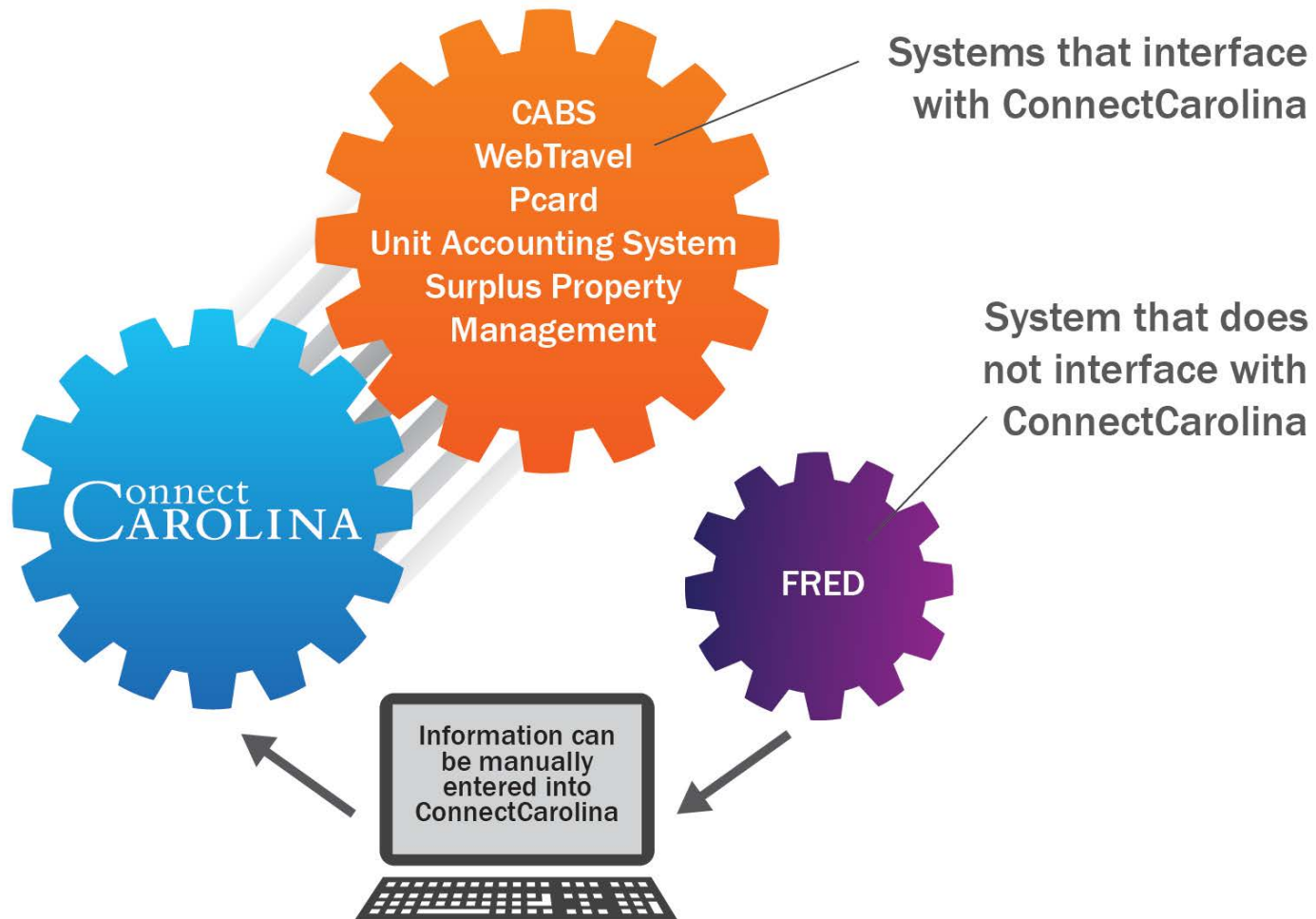
- HR/Payroll and Finance join Campus Solutions in ConnectCarolina
- Major changes:
 - Chart of Accounts is changing from simple FRS structure to more complex PeopleSoft chartfields
 - Department numbers are changing from 4 digits to 6 digits; number of departments greatly expanded
 - New business processes
 - New systems with new interfaces, new concepts for entering and retrieving data
 - New reporting tools
 - New sources of person, department and account information
 - No one will be an expert on Day 1 (not in central offices and not on campus)

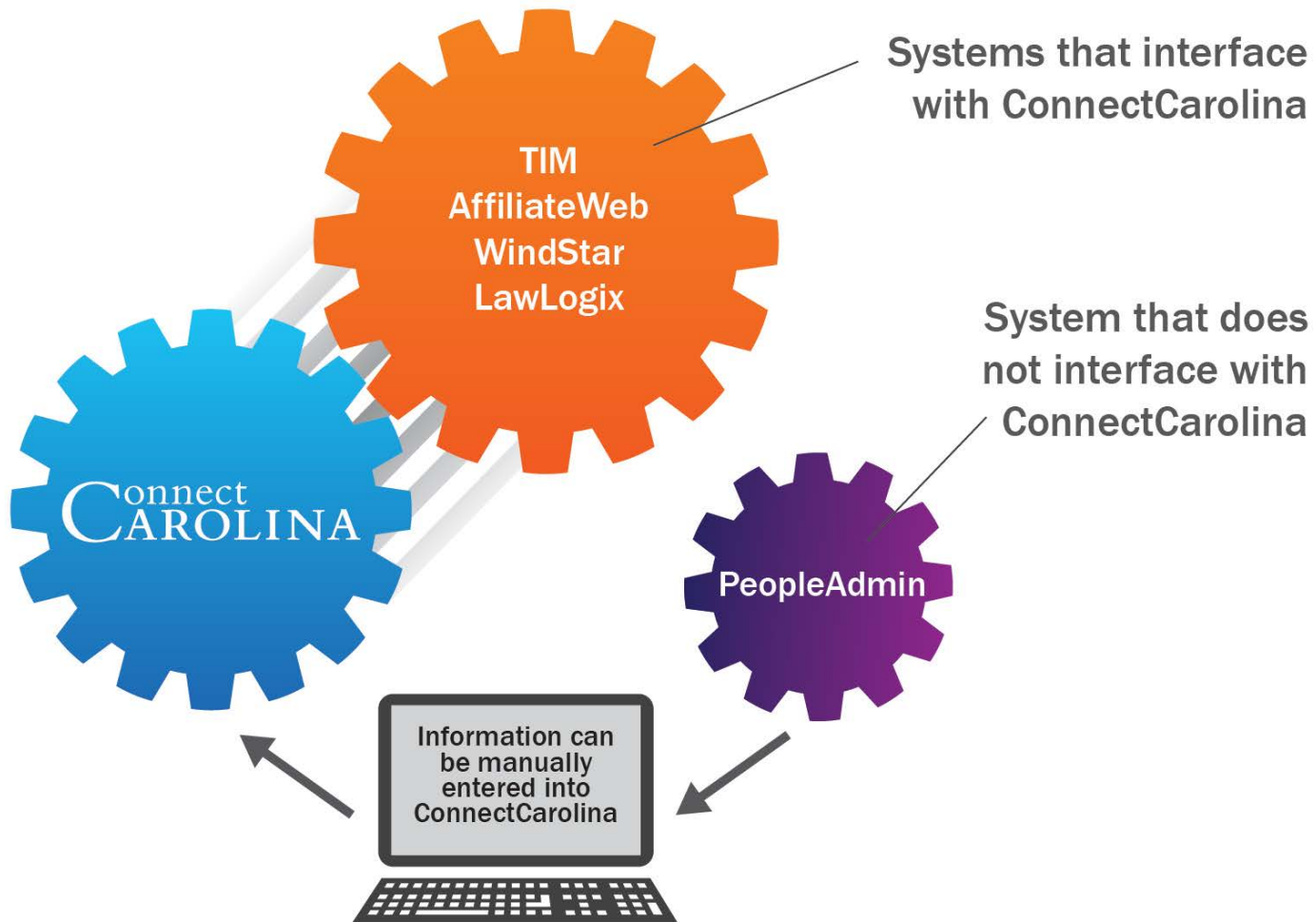


- Paychecks and accessing paycheck stubs
- Purchasing goods and services
- Hiring consultants or staff
- Purchasing software
- Submitting vouchers for payment
- Charging for services
- Signing up for HR's training courses
- Obtaining person, department and account code information
- Monitoring expenditures
- Reporting on budgets and costs
- Managing grants, departments, schools, and divisions

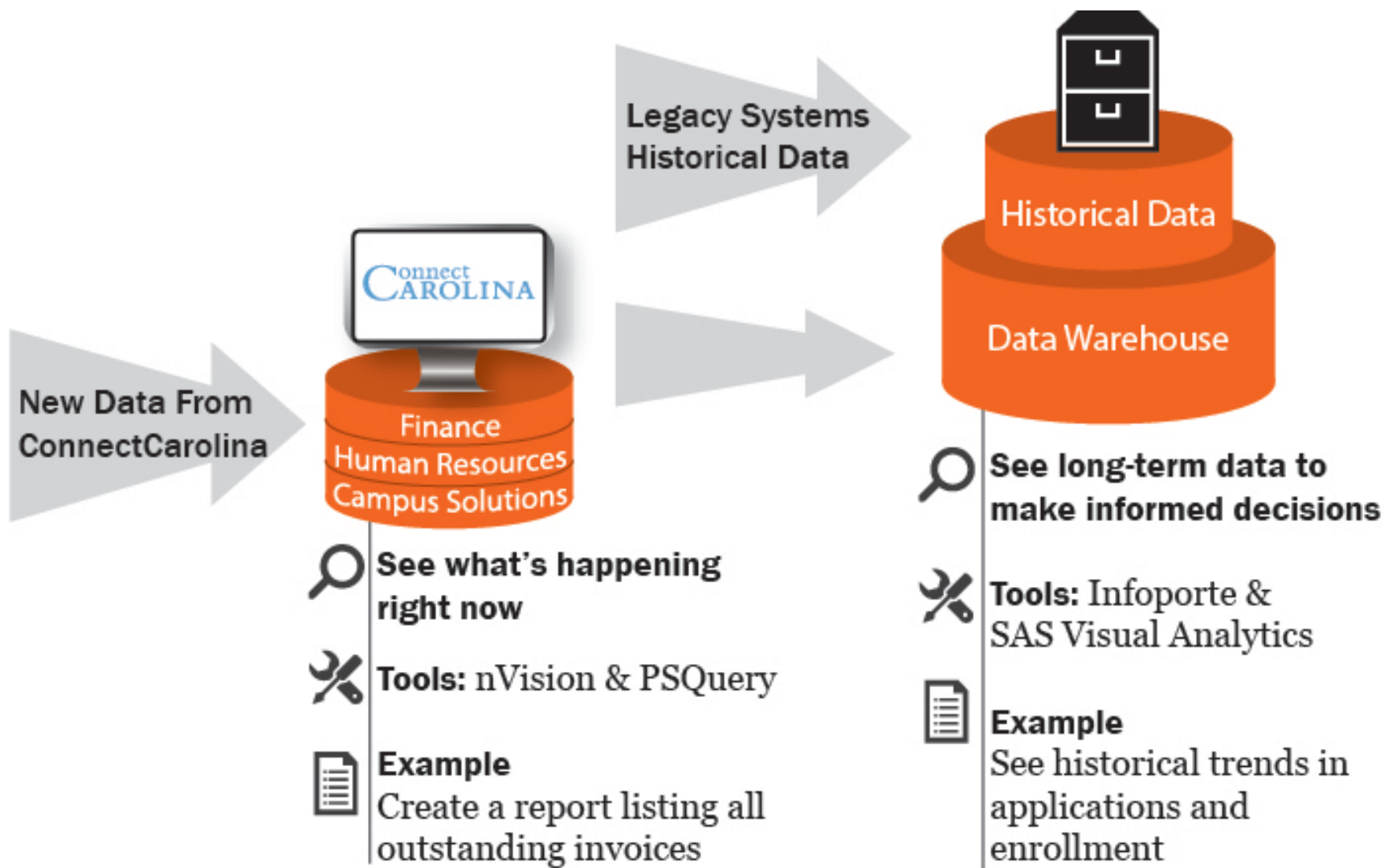
Finance Systems Not Replaced by ConnectCarolina

 - 6-digit department number replaces old 4-digit department number
- Portal provides single site for access to CC Applications
- ImageNow provides image upload and retrieval capabilities via PeopleSoft for some transactions
- Interfaces with other systems
- Departmental Data Access (DDA) data flow
- Printing from ConnectCarolina
- Security – Single Sign-on Authentication
- Firewall Settings: VPN for off-campus access and UNC-Secure for on-campus wireless access

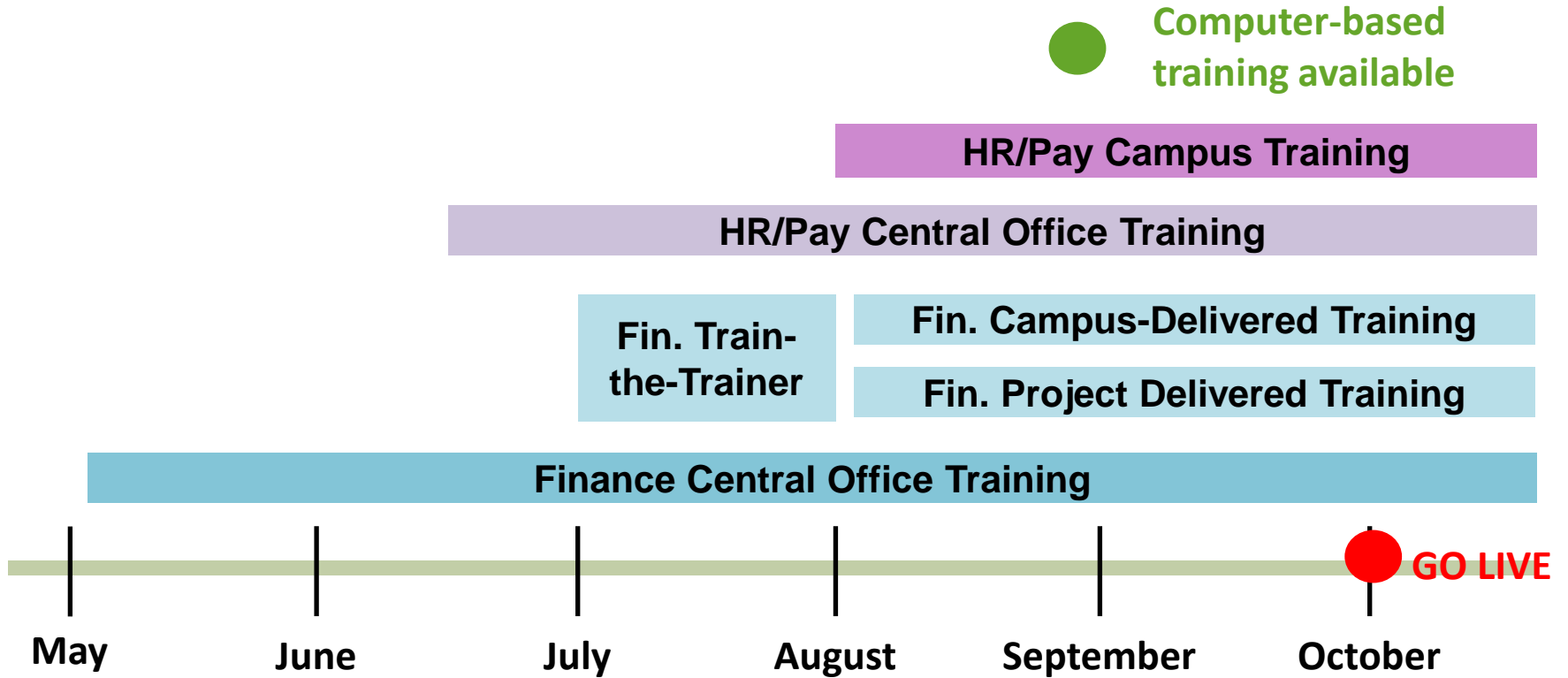
Recommended Browsers

			
Internet Explorer 9 or greater	Firefox 26 or greater	Safari 5 or 6 (Safari 7 and earlier versions are not supported)	Chrome 28 or greater

- Compatibility View in Internet Explorer (IE)
 - ConnectCarolina will work best if the Compatibility View is turned on in IE
- ConnectCarolina performs fastest with IE 10
- Next best is Mozilla Firefox
- Recommended browsers document on ccinfo.unc.edu website and on portal landing page (connectcarolina.unc.edu)

- Training is REQUIRED to get access to the system
- Over 4,500 people require training
- Types of training
 - Instructor-led by professional trainers
 - Train-the-Trainer model (finance only)
 - Instructor-led by School or Division peers
 - Computer-Based Training

High-Level Training Schedule



- Help schools and units prepare for cutover
- Includes checklist for End User PC Readiness
- Was sent to the MOU leads and HR Officers about a week and a half ago
- Can be shared with you; check with your MOU lead or HR Officer about taking a look

Project Timeline



- Details of cutover to be released very, very soon
- Includes:
 - Dates when transactions will cease in legacy systems
 - Timeline for conversions into PeopleSoft
 - How to handle “in-flight” items from legacy systems
 - Date when transactions will begin in PeopleSoft

- New Help Desk Organization Established
 - Reports to Priscilla Alden, AVC User Support & Engagement, ITS
 - A separate unit from ITS Help Desk to provide Finance and HR support
 - Will use ITS Help Desk technology
- Staffing
 - Recruiting for Director of Business Systems Help Desk
 - HR Support Lead plus 3 FTEs (transferring positions from OHR)
 - Finance Support Lead plus 4 FTEs (new positions to be staffed)
